MONTHLY FUN CLUB EVENT (MAY 16)

- An excellent occasion to meet other club members.
- Open to all members. Guests are welcome.
- May 16 starting at 9:00 a.m.
- Tee off times to be awarded on the basis of first come first registered and paid. Maximum 36 players.
- Prizes will be awarded by draws.
- Participants must register and pay no later than May 9
- The format will be individual stroke play
- There will be a steak luncheon available at 1:30 p.m. for the modest fee of \$15.00 (normal cost is \$25.00 but the membership fund managed by the Committee will contribute \$10.00 for the participating members)
- Guests will have to pay the full \$25.00 for the luncheon and green fees and, if applicable, rental of motorized carts.
- Registration fee for members and guests is \$5.00. Members will pay for carts if rented.
- Guests will pay green fees and other costs such as carts
- To participate please registered and pay at the golf shop and get your tee-off time. Also, indicate if will be attending dinner and for dinner at the time of registration.

HOLE-IN-ONE (MAY 29 – SEPT 6)

- Open to all members
- To be eligible you must register and pay a \$10 fee for 2010.
- Your \$10 fee must be paid by envelope before a hole in one is made.
- A registered paid player who makes the first one-in-one during the period of May 29 and September 6, 2010 will win 80% the money in the fund at that time. The remaining 20% will remain in the fund.
- If no player obtains a hole-in-one during the period of May 29 and September 6, 2010, the money collected will all be carried over to the 2011 golf season.
- A participating member who makes a hole-in-one will be require to have a witness and both the (skilled/lucky) member and the witness(es) will sign the scorecard and give it to the golf shop attendant at the conclusion of the 18 hole round.

TEE-OFF STARTS AT 7:30 A.M. EVERY DAY.

4 ROUNDS OF GOLF – 3 BEST SCORES WILL COUNT.

- Open to members.
- (A player who is unable to play all four rounds on the dates indicated above may play one (1) round between June 20 and June 26 provided that he informs the men's captain before June 19 and that when he plays that one round, he is accompanied by another qualifier member and that both sign the score card.)
- Participants must have an established handicap.
- All players will tee off from the white blocks.
- Scoring: Stableford. 8 best total scores of 3 rounds will qualify.
- The 2009 club champion qualifies automatically.
- In addition, the men's captain may select a tenth player.
- 10th and 11th best scores will qualify as alternates players 11th and 12th.

- Must have an established handicap
- The best 10 total points will qualify as follows:
 - o Two (2) 55 - 59 yrs. Old
 - o Two (2) 60 - 64 yrs. Old
 - o Two (2) 65 years old and over
 - o Two (2) next best scores
 - o Two (2) alternate (must be over 60)
- Scoring: Stableford
- Grouping :
 - o 1st day : by draw
 - o 2nd day : by scoring of round 1
 - o 3rd day : by total score of 2 first rounds
- Deadline to register Sunday July 25, 2010
- Entry fee: \$10.00
- P.S. entry fee must be pay by deadline using registration envelope and given to Ron Markel or left at the golf shop with attendant.
- If one round is cancelled, the tournament will be shortened to 36 holes.
- The 6 players having played the best total points will qualify. In addition the senior club champion will automatically qualify. Furthermore, the men’s captain may select an 8th player. - Regular scoring.
- The entry fee for “Senior” Club Championship is \$10.00
- Deadline to register and pay: August 7, 2010
- P.S. entry fee must be paid by deadline of August 7, 2010 using the registration envelope and put into box in the golf shop for that purpose.
- The senior club championship will be awarded to the player who has the lowest total of the 3 rounds (total gross score).
- A prize will also be awarded to the senior who has the best net score of the total 3 rounds. To be eligible for the low net prize, participants must have a registered up-to-date handicap.
- P.S. if one round is cancelled, that one round will be played on September 1 or 3 (subject to course availability). If two rounds are cancelled, the tournament will be cut back to 36 holes and with the second round to be played either on September 1 or 3 (subject to course availability).

2010 MEN’S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP - SEPTEMBER 4, 5 AND 6

- Open to members.
- September 4, 5 and 6
- First tee off at 7:30 a.m. on September 4 and 5, and at approximately 8:00 a.m. on September 6.
- September 6 round to be followed by lunch (at a minimal cost) to those interested.
- Best total lowest score of 3 rounds (best gross) and (best net) of each Class (“A”, “B” and “C”). The player with the best gross of the 3 rounds being declared the Club Champion.
- Winners will be declared as follows:
 - o Club champion (best overall gross score irrespective of Class)
 - o Best gross Class “A”
 - o Best gross Class “B”
 - o Best Gross Class “C”
 - o Best net Class “A”
 - o Best net Class “B”
 - o Best net Class “C”

- First tee off at approximately 8:00 a.m. on September 4 and 5 and at 9:00 a.m. on September 6
- September 6 round to be followed by lunch (at a minimal cost) to those interested.
- Best total lowest score of 3 rounds (best gross) and (best net).
- Regular scoring
- The entry fee for Club Championship is \$10.00
- Must have a registered up-to-date handicap to be eligible for low net.
- Deadline for registration and pay is August 29, 2010.
- The ladies club championship will be awarded to the player who has the best total gross score of the 3 rounds. A prize will also be awarded to the best net score of the total 3 rounds. In the event that one round is cancelled due to inclement weather, that one round will be played on September 1 if all participating players can participate. Otherwise, the tournament will be cut back to 36 holes only. If two rounds are cancelled due to inclement weather, one round will be played on September 1.
