We are committed this season to having better communication with our members throughout the year via email. We intend to send monthly updates regarding member events at the course, updated 2023 tournament schedule and promotions for our members.

In order for all golfers to have an exceptional experience, we need the cooperation of all members, therefore we want to lay out all policies and members' responsibilities throughout the golfing season.

Membership Benefits

- 10 Days advance booking either by phone (can book between 7am-5pm) or through our Online booking system
- Exclusive Deals and Promotion through Broken Stick Brewery, Hammond Hill and Eaglewoods Driving Range, along with our other partners

General Membership Policies

- 2023 Memberships expire on December 31, 2023
- Members may be asked to provide identification by staff to verify membership
- All members must check in at the Pro Shop prior to proceeding to the first tee to obtain ticket for the Starter – NO Ticket NO Golf – please arrive at least 15 minutes early prior to start time
- Members are responsible for guests they've booked for in advance
- Hammond Golf, Broken Stick and Hammond Hill firmly believe in creating a Safe Place for Everyone
- Homophobia, Racism, Sexism, Transphobia and Bullying will not be tolerated in any form by ownership and its staff
- Please let our staff know if any individual is making you or anyone else feel uncomfortable or unsafe while visiting Hammond Golf

General Course Etiquette

- Always replace your divots and/or fill with sand mix provided
- Keep pace during your round
- Be quiet when golfers are preparing to hit their shot
- Always rake bunkers after use
- Play 'Ready Golf' but always be aware of fellow golfers' position around you
- Respect on course signage and directions from Starters and Play Coordinators
- No carts on the green or in areas roped off by maintenance staff
- Carts should be returned to cart cleaning area in a timely manner once the round is over so other members may have access to carts – NO CARTS in the Parking area for more than 10 minutes please.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Once on the 10th tee, if a group ahead of you was not there on the front nine, please inform a marshal and he will confirm with the tee sheet that the group ahead has permission to start on the 10th hole

Cancelling Tee Times

- The below policies will be our initial procedures for 2023 – these procedures MAY change at any time and members will be made aware through email if new policies are put in place for the 2023 season
- **Members have until 6pm the day prior to cancel or change a tee time**
- Pro Shop will be open between 7am – 7pm to cancel tee times if for any reason the online system isn't working - please make the effort to cancel if you cannot make a tee time
- Members have the responsibility to check the weather for the next day as cancellations due to poor weather conditions will not be acceptable
- **Members are responsible for 'Guests' and their Green Fee in case of a no-show**
- Members who 'no-show' will be charged a green fee should they NOT check-in with the Pro Shop for their tee time

Dress Code Policy

Our Clubs offer a progressive atmosphere that recognizes the contemporary lifestyle of our Members and guests. Tasteful and respectful attire is expected in all public areas of the Club. As a courtesy to each other, we ask Members and their guests to follow the following guidelines:

- Appropriate golf course attire for men include: Tops designed and tailored for golf (shirts with collars); bottoms designed and tailored for golf (excludes denim); golf shoes or athletic shoes without spikes
- Appropriate golf course attire for women include: tops designed and tailored for golf (including those without collars or sleeves); bottoms designed and tailored for golf (leggings are

acceptable, denim is not); golf shoes or athletic shoes without spikes. Dresses tailored for golf and appropriate length are acceptable.

- Appropriate clubhouse attire includes: all golf attire as noted above; denim and other casual wear in good repair and tastefully tailored is acceptable.
- If you are unsure of the appropriateness of your attire, please contact us to confirm.
- We also ask Members to please forward a copy of the Dress Code to their guest(s) prior to their arrival at the Club to help eliminate any potential dress code issues.

Golf Carts

- Hammond Golf does provide complimentary access to 'push carts' for Members and guests
- A power cart rental fee will apply on a per rider basis for all Members and guests who ride a power cart unless purchased in conjunction with their membership
- In conjunction with the rental a golf cart, the driver/renter of the cart accepts that he or she will operate the cart in a safe manner, will adhere to all rules set forth by Hammond Golf, and accepts complete liability for any damages to the golf cart or personal property. The driver/renter voluntarily agrees and accepts the risks of using a golf cart, and on behalf of the driver/renter, any passengers in the cart, any personal representatives and heirs hereby voluntarily release Hammond Golf its owners, officers, employees, and agents from any and all claims, actions, causes of actions, suits, judgments that may in any way or manner arise out of use of the golf cart. It is strictly forbidden that a minor or any individual without a valid driver's license operate the golf cart.
- The driver/renter of the golf cart will return the golf cart to the locally designated return area, not leave the golf cart in the car parking lot and for further safety will have possession/control of golf cart keys if the golf cart is ever left unattended.
- The use of personal golf vehicles such as golf bikes, golf boards, Segways and others are prohibited on property.
- Power caddies and other equipment not designed to transport a golfer are welcome. Persons with disabilities may use their own assistive devices as required when accessing goods or services provided.

Rain Check Policies

- In the event a person does not complete 12 holes due to inclement weather, the 18-hole value will be issued as a Rain Check
- In the event a person plays 13 holes or more (tees off on the 13th hole), no Rain Check will be issued.
- For 9-Hole Rounds, in the event a person does not complete 6 holes due to inclement weather, the 9-hole value will be issued as a Rain Check
- In the event a person plays 7 holes or more (tees off on the 7th hole), no Rain Check will be issued.
- This policy applied to Golf Carts as well

Alcohol & Cannabis Policy

- No alcoholic beverages other than those provided by the Club are permitted anywhere on the premises
- Hammond Golf strictly adhere to all provisions of the provincial liquor control and licensing regulations
- Club staff reserve the right to examine the contents of golf bags and other items for personal alcohol.
- No person shall consume alcoholic beverages or consume cannabis to the point of impairment or intoxication
- Members not adhering to these rules will be asked to leave the Club immediately and will be subject to an automatic suspension of membership privileges
- Any guest not adhering to these rules must leave the property immediately and future access to the Club may be denied
- The Club assumes no liability for any injury, wrongdoing, or problem caused by the breach of these rules.
- As a condition of the use of the Club's premises and, more particularly, the provision of alcoholic beverages by the Club, all persons hereby expressly waive any liability on the part of the Club arising out of the consumption of alcoholic beverages and agree to indemnify and save harmless the Club from any and all claims, damages or lawsuits referable to the consumption of alcoholic beverages
- Like alcohol, consuming marijuana in any form shall be done in a respectful and responsible manner
- Hammond Golf Course will arrange for, at the cost of the member/guest, an Uber or a Taxi for individuals who we deem to be too inebriated to drive home from the golf course as safety is our primary concern for all people at Hammond Golf
